

Miniguide to Biblical Cosmology

At that time, saith the LORD, they shall bring out the bones of the kings of Judah, and the bones of his princes, and the bones of the priests, and the bones of the prophets, and the bones of the inhabitants of Jerusalem, out of their graves:

And they shall spread them before the sun, and the moon,, and all the host of heaven, whom they have loved, and whom they heave served, and after whom they have walked, and whom they have sought, and whom they have worshipped – Jeremiah 8:1-2

1. God created the earth for man – He spreads out the earth & stretches out the heavens.
2. The earth is still with foundations – God shakes it to get our attention.
3. The earth is placed on streaming waters, not in a vacuum.
4. God placed a solid firmament in this waters.
5. The sun and the moon are two different lights placed in this firmament – they move in a fixed pattern above the earth.
6. The throne of God is right above the firmament.
7. The waters under the firmament is gathered in one place, with a limit, a container.
8. In heaven, on the earth and below the earth – there is no mentioning of an expanding universe and galaxies. **Note: there is water below the earth, not vacuum.**
9. When Jesus prayed, He **looked up** to the Father who sits on His throne.

1. God created the earth for man – He spreads out the earth & stretches out the heavens.

Job 26:7

He stretcheth out the north over the empty place, and hangeth the earth upon nothing.

Job 38:14

It [the earth] is turned as clay to the seal.

Isaiah 40:22

It is he that sitteth upon the circle of the earth, and the inhabitants thereof are as grasshoppers; that stretcheth out the heavens as a curtain, and spreadeth them out as a tent to dwell in.

Isaiah 42:5

Thus saith God the LORD, he that created the heavens, and stretched them out; he that spread forth the earth, and that whiwh cometh out of it; he that giveth breath unto the people upon it, and spirit to them that walk therein.

Isaiah 44:25

I m the LORD that maketh all things; that stretcheth forth the heavens alone; that spreadeth abroad the earth by myself.

Isaiah 45:18

For thus saith the LORD that created the heavens; God himself that formed the earth and made it; he hath established it, he created it not in vain, he formed it to be inhabited: I am the LORD; and there is no one else.

Isaiah 48:13

Mine hand also hath laid the foundation of the earth, and my right hand hath spanned the heavens.

Isaiah 66:1-2

Thus saith the LORD, The heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool: where is the house that ye build unto me? and where is the place of my rest?

For all those things hath mine hand made, and all those things have been, saith the LORD: but to this man will I look, even to him that is poor and of contrite spirit, and trembleth at my word.

2. The earth is still with foundations – God shakes it to get our attention.

1 Sam 2:8

for the pillars of the earth are the LORD'S, and he hath set the world upon them.

2 Sam 22:8

Then the earth shook and trembled; the foundations of heaven moved and shook, because he was wroth.

1 Chron 16:30

Fear before him, all the earth: the world also shall be stable, that it be not moved.

Job 9:6

Which shaketh the earth out of her place, and the pillars thereof tremble.

Job 38:4-6

Where wast thou when I laid the foundations of the earth? declare, if thou hast understanding. Who hath laid the measures thereof, if thou knowest? or who hath stretched the line upon it? Whereupon are the foundations thereof fastened? or who laid the corner stone thereof;

Psalms 18:7

Then the earth shook and trembled; the foundations also of the hills moved and were shaken, because he was wroth.

Psalms 75:3

The earth and all the inhabitants thereof are dissolved: I bear up the pillars of it.

Psalms 93:1

The LORD reigneth, he is clothed with majesty; the LORD is clothed with strength, wherewith he hath girded himself: the world also is stablished, that it cannot be moved.

Psalms 96:10

Say among the heathen that the LORD reigneth: the world also shall be established that it shall not be moved.

Psalms 104:5

Who laid the foundation of the earth, that it should not be removed for ever.

Isaiah 13:13

Therefore I will shake the heavens, and the earth shall remove out of her place.

Isaiah 48:13

Mine hand also hath laid the foundation of the earth, and my right hand hath spanned the heavens.

Jeremiah 31:37

Thus saith the LORD; If heaven above can be measured, and the foundations of the earth searched out beneath...

Zechariah 1:11

And they answered the angel of the LORD that stood among the myrtle trees, and said, We have walked to and fro through the earth, and, behold, all the earth sitteth still, and is at rest.

3. The earth is placed on streaming waters, not in a vacuum.

Genesis 1:1-2

In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.

Psalms 24:1-2

The earth is the LORD'S, and the fullness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein. For he hath founded it upon the seas, and established it upon the floods.

Psalms 136:6

To him that stretched out the earth above the waters: for his mercy endureth forever.

2 Peter 3:5

For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water.

4. God placed a solid firmament in these waters.

Genesis 1:6-8

And God said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters.

And God made the firmament, and divided the waters which were under the firmament from the waters which were above the firmament: and it was so.

And God called the firmament heaven.

Job 37:18

Hast thou with him spread out the sky, which is strong, and as a molten looking glass?

Psalms 19:1

The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork.

Psalms 148:4

Praise him, ye heavens of heavens, and ye waters that be above the heavens.

Proverbs 8:27

When he prepared the heavens, I was there: when he set a compass upon the face of the deep.

Isaiah 48:13

Mine hand also hath laid the foundation of the earth, and my right hand hath spanned the heavens.

2 Peter 3:10

But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise...

5. The sun and the moon are two different lights placed in this firmament – they move in a fixed pattern above the earth.

Genesis 1:14-17

And God said, Let there be lights in the firmament of the heaven to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs, and for seasons, and for days, and years:

And let them be for lights in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth: and it was so.

And God made two great lights; the greater light to rule the day, and the lesser light to rule the night: he made the stars also.

And God set them in the firmament of the heaven to give light upon the earth.

Joshua 10:12-14

and he said in the sight of Israel, Sun, stand thou still upon Gibeon; and thou, Moon, in the valley of Ajalon.

And the sun stood still, and the moon stood still... in the midst of heaven, and hasted not to go down about a whole day.

2 Kings 20:9-11

And Isaiah said, This sign shalt thou have of the LORD, that the LORD will do the thing that he hath spoken: shall the shadow go forward ten degrees, or go back ten degrees?

And Hezekiah answered, It is a light thing for the shadow to go down ten degrees: nay, but let the shadow return backward ten degrees.

And Isaiah the prophet cried unto the LORD: and he brought the shadow ten degrees backward, by which it had gone down in the dial of Ahaz.

Psalms 19:4-6

In them he set a tabernacle for the sun, Which is a bridegroom coming out of his chamber, and rejoiceth as a strong man to run a race.

His going forth is from the end of the heaven, and his circuit unto the ends of it: and there is nothing hid from the heat thereof.

Isaiah 38:8

Behold, I will bring again the shadow of the degrees, which is gone down in the sun dial of Ahaz, ten degrees backward. So the sun returned ten degrees, by which degrees it was gone down.

Jeremiah 31:35

Thus saith the LORD, which giveth the sun for at light by day, and the ordinances of the moon and of the stars for at light by night...

6. The throne of God is right above the firmament.

Exodus 24:9-10

Then went up Moses, and Aaron, Nadab, and Abihu, and seventy of the elders of Israel:
And they saw the God of Israel: and there was under his feet as it were a paved work of a sapphire stone, and as it were the body of heaven in his clearness.

Deuteronomy 33:26-27

There is none like unto the God of Jeshurun, who rideth upon the heaven in thy help, and in his excellency on the sky.
The eternal God is thy refuge, and underneath are the everlasting arms.

Job 22:14

Thick clouds are a covering to him, that he seeth not; and he walketh in the circuit of heaven.

Job 26:9

He holdeth back the face of his throne, and spreadeth his cloud upon it.

Isaiah 66:1-2

Thus saith the LORD, The heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool: where is the house the ye build unto me? and where is the place of my rest?

For all those things hath mine hand made, and all those things have been, saith the LORD: but to this man will I look, even to him that is poor and of contrite spirit, and trembleth at my word.

Ezekiel 1:22, 25-26 (read 22-28)

And the likeness of the firmament upon the heads of the living creature was as the colour of the terrible crystal, stretched forth over their heads above.

And there was a voice from the firmament that was over their heads, when they stood and had let down their wings.

And above the firmament that was over their heads was the likeness of a throne, as the appearance of a sapphire stone: and upon the likeness of the throne was the likeness as the appearance of a man above upon it.

Ezekiel 10:1

Then I looked, and, behold, in the firmament that was above the head of the cherubims there appeared over them as it were a sapphire stone, as the appearance of the likeness of a throne.

Amos 9:6

It is he that buildeth his stories in the heaven, and hath founded his troop in the earth

Revelation 4:2-3

And immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and one sat on the throne.

And he that sat was to look upon like a jasper and a sardine stone: and there was a rainbow round about the throne, in sight like unto an emerald.

7. The waters under the firmament is gathered in one place, with a limit, a container.

Genesis 1:9-10

And God said, Let the waters under the heaven be gathered together unto one place, and let the dry land appear: and it was so.

And God called the dry land Earth; and the gathering together of the waters called he Seas.

Job 38:14

It [the earth] is turned as clay to the seal.

Job 38:8, 10-11

Or who shut up the sea with doors, when it brake forth, as if it had issued out of the womb?

And brake up for it my decreed place, and set bars and doors,

And said, Hitherto shalt thou come, but no further: and here shall thy proud waves be stayed?

Proverbs 8:29

When he gave to the sea his decree, that the waters should not pass his commandment: when he appointed the foundations of the earth.

Jeremiah 5:22

Fear ye not me? saith the LORD: will ye not tremble at my presence, which have placed the sand for the bound of the sea by a perpetual decree, that it cannot pass it: and though the waves thereof toss themselves, yet can they not prevail; though they roar, yet can they not pass over it?

8. In heaven, on the earth and below the earth – there is no mentioning of an expanding universe and galaxies. Note: there is water below the earth, not vacuum.

Genesis 7:11

the same day were all the fountains of the great deep broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened.

Genesis 8:2

The fountains also of the deep and the windows of heaven were stopped, and the rain from heaven was restrained.

Exodus 20:4

Thou shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth.

Philippians 2:9-10

That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth.

Revelation 5:3 (read 1-5)

And no man in heaven, nor in the earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look thereon.

Revelation 14:7

Worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters.

9. When Jesus prayed, He *looked up* to the Father who sits on His throne.

Matthew 14:19 (also Mark 6:41 and Luke 9:16)

And he commanded the multitude to sit down on the grass, and took the five loaves, and the two fishes, and looking up to heaven, he blessed and brake, and gave the loaves to his disciples, and the disciples to the multitude.

John 11:40-43

Jesus said unto her, Said I not unto thee, that, if thou wouldest believe, thou shouldest see the glory of God?

Then they took away the stone from the place where the dead was laid. And Jesus lifted up his eyes, and said, Father, I thank thee that thou hast heard me.

John 17:1

These words spake Jesus, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee.

The Father answers Jesus

John 12:23-31

And Jesus answered them, saying, The hour is come, that the Son of man should be glorified.

Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die,
it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.

He that loveth his life shall lose it;
and he that hateth his life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal.

If any man serve me, let him follow me; and where I am, there shall also my servant be:
if any man serve me, him will my Father honour.

Now is my soul troubled; and what shall I say?

Father, save me from this hour: but for this cause came I unto this hour.

Father, glorify thy name.

Then came there a voice from heaven, saying, I have both glorified it, and will glorify it
again.

The people therefore, that stood by, and heard it, said that it thundered: others said,
An angel spake to him.

Jesus answered and said, **This voice came not because of me, but for your sakes.**

Now is the judgment of this world: now shall the prince of this world be cast out.

The heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool, Isaiah 66:1
